Basic Linux Commands

- `ls` - Lists directory contents.
- `cd` - Changes the current directory.
- `pwd` - Displays the present working directory.
- `cat` - Concatenates and displays files.
- `echo` - Displays arguments to the screen.
- `man` - Displays the online manual.
- `exit` - Exits the shell or your current session.
- `clear` - Clears the screen.

ls Options

-l long listing format

man Keyboard Commands

space - display the next page

q - quit
